Will Millennium Physician Group accept my unwanted medications?

No, Millennium Physician Group is not an authorized collection location as outlined by the State of Florida and the DEA.

Can I just flush them or throw them away?

If a take-back program, mail back program, or authorized disposal site is not available, please follow the "Seven Steps to Safety" as outlined on the Florida State Department's website: http://www.dep.state.fl.us/waste/quick_topics/publications/shw/meds/dontflushfinal.pdf

Can I return them to my pharmacy?

Check with your local pharmacy to see if they accept unwanted medications, some are authorized collection centers. Millennium Pharmacy Services is not an authorized disposal site.
